Our ethical policy covers:

The company policy is to comply with International Law, and to this end, the minimum labour standards are:-

- 1. CHILD LABOUR The Company does not support the use of child labour.
- 2. RIGHT OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING We recognise this as a human right, employees have a collective say over pay issues, Equality and Health and Safety.
- 3. DISCRIMINATION The Company does not support any discriminating practices in hiring, remuneration, promotion, training based on race, political belief, religion or any other factor and operates on the basis of Equal Opportunities.
- 4. HEALTH AND SAFETY The Company provides a safe and healthy working environment, in line with our Health and Safety policy. Sub-contractors must also run a Health and Safety policy ensuring employees work in premises which are safe and provide access to clean sanitary facilities and drinking water.
- 5. REMUNERATION The Company complies with National Laws both in the UK and offshore where our products are produced.
- 6. WORKING HOURS The Company complies with the applicable laws on working hours Oldham and holiday entitlements. This applies to overseas contractors in the same way.
